Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited to announce that the Math Department will offer a Trigonometry class during the summer of 2010. This course includes in-depth study of elementary trigonometric and transcendental functions. There will be a strong emphasis on a graphical approach and the class is designed to be a bridge for higher mathematics.

The class will run Monday through Friday from June 21-July 23, 2010 at Elizabeth Seton High School. Students will have July 5, 2010 off due to the holiday. The class will begin at 8am and will end at 11:15am. Attendance is mandatory. The cost of the class will be \$320 with a non-refundable deposit of \$100 due by May 14. The remaining \$220 will be due by June 4. The payment should be brought to Mrs. Burke.

The current Algebra II textbook will be used. The title of the book is "Algebra II" by Larson, Boswell, Kanold and Stiff. Please note that a grade of B or higher is expected in order to enroll in Honors Pre-Calculus.
