Dear Parents and Students,

We apologize that this letter is arriving with little notice but as you can imagine, the inclement weather has set us back. On the national test date of May 1, our college-bound juniors will make the important step in their academic careers by taking the SAT. Elizabeth Seton High School will offer an SAT Preparatory Course to help them make that step with confidence. The course will begin on Thursday, February 25, 2010. See the schedule below for specific class dates and times.

Elizabeth Seton's SAT prep course will provide an introduction to the SAT format, effective strategies for answering questions, and rigorous coaching for each specific subject area tested. Focal points of the program include intensive mathematical review, reading comprehension improvement, vocabulary development, writing skills enrichment, test anxiety control, concentration enhancement, and time management.

The Critical Reading and Writing offers 18 hours of instruction. This includes one 3-hour Saturday and one 3-hour Thursday (on a day when there are no classes.) The Mathematics section offers 15 hours of instruction. Critical Reading and Writing includes more hours in order to adequately cover the writing section. **Students are expected to attend all sessions.**

Tuition for the SAT course is \$300. This fee includes all materials needed for the course. Payment for the course may be broken up into two payments of \$150 each. The first payment is due February 24 and the second payment is due March 30. Students taking the SAT Prep Course are **required** to register for the May 1 SAT. The registration deadline for the May 1 SAT is March 25. **Registration information is available in the Guidance Office, or by visiting www.collegeboard.com.** Enrollment for the SAT course is limited. If possible, we will offer two sections. Registration forms and payment should be received in the Guidance Office as soon as possible, and no later than February 24, 2010. Applications will be accepted on a first come basis.
