TRANSPORTATION

CAREER PROGRAMS

LEAD PROGRAM

(LEARNING ENGINEERING AND DESIGN)

Learning Engineering and Design is a four-year curriculum in STEM instruction. The courses increase understanding of engineering design and application while preparing students for college level courses in engineering and technology.

AGNES M. BROWN LAW ACADEMY

Law Academy students explore issues relating to law, the legal profession, the court systems, and individual rights.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

The program is designed to meet the Maryland State Board of Pharmacy requirements and is one of only two high school programs approved by the state.

HOSPITALITY & TOURISM MANAGEMENT

Students who complete this academic program and internship will be eligible for globally recognized certifications with industry credentials.
